

Abstract/Proposal Title:

Institutional change in new e-learning partnerships: University of New South Wales and the Australian Command & Staff College.

Abstract/Proposal description:

The University of New South Wales at the Australian Defence Force Academy (UNSW@ADFA) and the Australian Command and Staff College – Army Reserve (ACSC (R)) have recently signed a contract whereby materials are provided through the OLIVE LMS (Learning Management System) run by UNSW@ADFA. While complete in itself, this program is also acting as a pilot study for e-learning provision by the larger ACSC community. ACSC (R) members are part-time reservists located across Australia. Provision of accessible web-based e-learning in their workplaces and homes will enable larger numbers of staff to access this training.

Implications for Practice:

Implications for the wider ACSC community, for both reservists and full-time serving members are also discussed.

Significant Outcomes/Insights:

This case study examines the changes required across each institution to enable this contract to be implemented, including changes to business processes, pedagogy and assessment processes.

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
